# **SECTION 02482 DREDGING AND DISPOSAL**

#### PART 1 - GENERAL

#### SUBMITTALS

- **A.1.g** Proposed dredge cuts, and for each cut, associated volume and disposal location. Based on this information, also include the anticipated daily disposal rate at the Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11), Montezuma Wetlands Restoration Project (MWRP), and at the San Francisco Deep Ocean Disposal Site (SF-DODS). Contractor must notify the Port immediately if a deviation is made from the proposed disposal plan.
- **A.1.h** The material and equipment utilized to transport the dredged material to the Alcatraz Disposal Site (SF-11), Montezuma Wetlands Restoration Project (MWRP), and at the San Francisco Deep Ocean Disposal Site (SF-DODS).

# PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.02.B San Francisco Deep Ocean Disposal Site (SF-DODS): Unless noted or specified otherwise, no less than 46,000 cubic yards of the dredge material within the dredge limits as shown on the Contract Documents from Dredge Unit 1-01 (DU-1-01), Dredge Unit 2 (DU-2), <u>Dredge Unit 3 (DU-3)</u>, <u>Dredge Unit 4 (DU-4)</u>, and Dredge Unit 5 (DU-5) shall be transported from the dredge site and disposed of at San Francisco Deep Ocean Disposal Site (SF-DODS). For disposal operations at SF-DODS, Contractor shall allow observers, upon request from the Point Reyes Bird Observatory or other appropriate independent observers to be present on disposal vessels on all trips to the ocean disposal area for the purpose of conduction surveys of marine habitats. The Contractor

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shall allow the independent observers to be present on a sufficient number of vessel trips to characterize fully the potential impact of disposal site use on marine habitats. At a minimum, the Contractor shall allow independent observers on at least one disposal trip in any calendar month in which a disposal trip to the ocean disposal are is made. For other SF-DODS disposal site conditions, Contractor is to read attached Appendix 08 EPA Standard Ocean Disposal Conditions for the San Francisco Deep Ocean Disposal Site (SF-DODS).
